If the flower is behind a woman's left ear, she is in a relationship.

If it is worn behind the right ear, she is willing to meet a romantic partner.

In Buddhist culture, the plumeria represents immortality.



the Ukulele

This small 4 stringed instrument is a big part of the folk culture of Hawaii. Modeled after an instrument brought to the islands from Portugal, the ukulele's name translates to "jumping fleas", a unique way to describe what it looks like when the instrument is played.
